What does it take to become an Ambassador?

- Strong academic, interpersonal, and organizational skills.
- Desire to share your Central Virginia Community College experience with others.
- At least a 2.5 GPA, with a minimum of six credit hours completed at CVCC by the end of fall 2018.
- Availability to serve as an Ambassador during the following semesters: summer 2019, fall 2019, and spring 2020.

Ambassador Expectations (Required):

- Provide tours of campus to visiting groups.
- Obtain a background check through our Human Resources Department.
- Assist with information tables at the beginning of each semester.
- Attend Ambassador training May 21 & 23, 2019.
- Attend the VCCS Student Leadership Conference in November 15-17, 2019.
- Maintain at least a 2.5 GPA each semester: spring 2019-spring 2020.
- Maintain enrollment of at least six credits during fall 2019 and spring 2020.
- Staff at least 30 hours of campus service per semester, during fall 2019 and spring 2020.

Ambassador Program Benefits:

- Develop leadership skills and build your resume.
- Serve the CVCC campus community.
- Get to know other student leaders, as well as key faculty and staff.
- Obtain a \$1,000 scholarship: \$500 for fall 2019 and \$500 for spring 2020.
