What does it take to become an Ambassador?

- Strong academic, interpersonal, and organizational skills.
- Desire to share your Central Virginia Community College experience with others.
- At least a 2.5 GPA, with a minimum of 6 credit hours completed at CVCC by the end of Fall 2016. Current high school students are not eligible.
- Availability to serve as an Ambassador during the following semesters: Summer 2017, Fall 2017, and Spring 2018.

Ambassador Expectations (Required):

- Provide tours of campus to visiting groups.
- Assist with information tables at the beginning of each semester.
- Attend Ambassador training May 30-31, 2017.
- Attend the VCCS Student Leadership Conference in November 2017
- Maintain at least a 2.5 GPA each semester: Spring 2017-Spring 2018.
- Maintain enrollment of at least 6 credits during Fall 2017 and Spring 2018.
- Staff at least 30 hours of campus service per semester, during Fall 2017 and Spring 2018.

Ambassador Program Benefits:

- Develop leadership skills and build your resume.
- Serve the CVCC campus community.
- Get to know other student leaders, as well as key faculty and staff.
- Obtain a \$1,000 scholarship: \$500 for Fall 2017 and \$500 for Spring 2018.
